

- Globally, at least 2.2 billion people have a near or distance vision impairment<sup>2</sup>
- Adults with vision impairment often have lower rates of workforce participation and productivity and higher rates of depression and anxiety<sup>2</sup>
- 1-in-4 school-age children have a vision disorder<sup>3</sup>
- Up to 80% of learning comes through the eyes<sup>3</sup>
